St. Charles Children's Home is a group home for children between the ages of 3 and 12 from families in crisis. The Children's Home is a program of New Hampshire Catholic Charities, staffed by the Daughters of Mary, Mother of Healing Love. The Sisters work with both the children and their families with the goal of healing and reunification. When reunification is not possible, the children are prepared for transition into an adoptive family. Volunteers assist the staff with games, recreational programs, chaperoning on trips and household tasks. Good role modeling, congeniality and a commitment to consistency is very important. Those interested in volunteering should contact Mother Paul Marie. The home runs periodic orientation meetings for prospective volunteers. All volunteers go through a screening process.
